As a result of the introduction of a new water-saving irrigation system on 25 thousand hectares of cotton fields this year, three times more harvest than last year is expected, and 1 million 100 thousand hectares of unused land will be returned to use.

In this regard, the following tasks are defined and their performance should be monitored by the management staff. They are:

- > improvement of agricultural land use;
- > increase the efficiency of water use;
- > state support for agriculture and improvement of the state procurement system;
- > increasing the export potential of agriculture and increasing the volume of products with added value;
- Formation of a competitive environment in the field of agricultural services;
- > wide implementation of information technologies in agriculture and ensuring the accuracy of data through full digitization of agricultural statistics;
- it will be necessary to solve the issue of personnel, to develop science.

"The role of the state is to increase the labor productivity of farmers and peasant farms, to ensure the safety and quality of food products, to protect the environment and the private sector directing to the provision of public services necessary for other purposes that are not provided" was one of the important reasons for the liberalization and further development of the agricultural sector through privatization.

The main goal of the management staff in the development of agriculture is to further improve the living conditions of the villagers and ensure their interest. That is, it is necessary to change the old way of agriculture, which has been used until now, and fundamentally reform the sector, which has become a source of raw material production. That's why it's time to work anew. At the meeting held on September 6, 2020, during 2020-2030, improving the use of agricultural land, increasing the efficiency of water use, state support for agriculture, and the system of public procurement improvement, increasing the export potential of agriculture and increasing the volume of products with added value, forming a competitive environment in the field of agricultural services, wide introduction of information technologies in agriculture and full digitalization of industry statistics seven priority areas

Today, the issue of effective use of available land and water in Uzbekistan was defined by the President as the most urgent task for the workers and scientists of the field. The reason is that land is limited. It is necessary to get more income from this limited land only by increasing labor productivity and productivity.

If we compare with developed countries, it seems that there are a number of systemic problems in the level of land and water resources use. Therefore, in the strategy, special emphasis is placed on increasing labor productivity in agriculture, effective use of available resources, and wide application of innovative technologies.

CONCLUSION

In short, Uzbekistan is among the countries where agriculture is actively supported. Today, managers are given wide opportunities for the development of agriculture in New Uzbekistan. On the other hand, there are responsibilities and tasks on the responsibility of the employees. The state allocates 2-3 times more funds to the agricultural sector than in developed countries. Therefore, until 2025, the state will regulate agriculture only on the basis of market mechanisms.
